In our maths lessons we weighed out the ingredients to make cornflake cakes...




...and explored different capacities with water and jugs....it was great fun!


Next, we went on safari to the animal kingdom to learn all about different animals and their habitats.

We listened to their special story and found out how to keep our pets happy and healthy.






We identified, named and labelled different parts of the human body!

In the first week we made and tasted a full English breakfast and a French continental breakfast and compared the two.







We told each other how to make jam sandwiches to help us with our instruction writing.
