We learnt about different places of worship and ended the half-term with a visit to Thorney Island Church to meet the Padre.










Each week of this half term we have cooked dishes from different countries!

We dressed up as a character from our favourite book - don't we look great?






At Easter we hatched some chicks at school and enjoyed watching them grow and having lots of cuddles!

Next, we went on safari to the Animal Kingdom to learn all about different animals and their habitats.






We found out all about our class Guinea Pigs called Bob and Brian.
