For our topic this half term we will be learning all about animals! We will be reading lots of animal related stories and finding out different facts about a range of different animals. For an exciting experience for the class, we will be having our own class pet that we need to take responsibility for and look after ourselves!

In Maths we will be looking at length, height, weight and volume this half term. Children could look at measuring objects around the home, comparing the heights, lengths or weights between 2 different objects or helping to cook looking at the weights and volume of food and liquids. We will also be securing our knowledge of place value to 100.

In our phonics lessons we will be going over all the Phase 5 sounds that we have previously learnt. Homework will be based around our phonics to ensure children are really confident with this. A grid with the Phase 5 sounds was sent out at the beginning of the school year and has been uploaded onto Seesaw. It would benefit your child greatly if they could practise these sounds at home! You could give your child 3 or 4 sounds of the week and they can list different words that they can think of using that sound - we would love to see the work they do!

READING!

As ever, reading is such an important part of your child's education, especially at this early stage. Please try and read with your child everyday if you can. This doesn't always have to be sitting down with a book - they could read anything they see when they are out such as shop signs, labels in shops, posters, leaflets etc.
