English

Our learning will be focussed on the book: The Great Fire of London Anniversary Edition in which we will be exploring the diary entries of Samuel Pepys and having a go at writing our own imagining we were there. You could help your child at home by:

Encouraging them to keep a diary about what they have done over the week or to write an imaginary diary e.g., the diary of a superhero or spy.

Discussing the layout and words used in a diary.

Showing your child the layout of a letter and ask them to write a letter to a family member explaining what they are learning at school.

Maths

Some of the things that we will be exploring include:

- Addition and subtraction
- Money
- Multiplication

You could help your child at home by:

Asking children to add and subtract with things around the house. E.g Sweets, toys.

Giving your child experience of handling money and playing shop and calculating change.

Practicing Maths Minute Games and times tables for the 2, 5 and 10 times table.

I would like to extend a warm friendly welcome to any parents who could spare an hour or two to listen to children read in Falcon Class each week. Reading is a vital skill for children which enables them to learn and progress and your involvement makes a significant difference.

History
