<u>English</u>

We will be looking at the fantastic book *Curiosity: The Story of the Mars Rover* by Markus Motum and designing our own rover to send to Mars that we will then be writing about and explaining how it works.

Reading every day and developing a love for the subject is vital to success across so many different areas of the curriculum. Please ensure that your child reads every night and that they have their book in school every day. To assist the work that we will be doing in school, when your child reads to you please ask them some comprehension questions about what they have read.

- Summarise what has happened in the book so far
- Why is a character behaving in a particular way, what might this tell us about their character?
- What do you think might happen next?
- What does this word mean in the context of the story?

<u>PE</u>

One lesson per week will focus on building key fundamental movement skills, whilst the other lesson will focus on gymnastics. Our PE days are Mondays and Tuesday, but with Christmas performance rehearsals etc. this may well change, please ensure that your child has their PE kit in school every day and that it contains their full PE kit- white shirt, black shorts (they will need shorts not trousers for gymnastics) and suitable shoes for running outdoors). Long hair should be tied up and earrings taken out (or covered with micropore tape). <u>Maths</u>

In maths we will be using our multiplication knowledge a lot this half term. Fractions and multiplication are so tightly linked together and we will focussing on both of these strands this half term by:

- Looking at multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1,000
- Finding equivalent fractions
- Converting between improper fractions and mixed numbers
- Ordering and comparing fractions with different denominators
- Adding fractions with different denominators
- Subtracting fractions with different denominators

As I have said above, multiplication knowledge is vital for everything that we are doing this half term, and makes the learning so much easier. Please ensure that your child continues to practise their times tables regularly to build speed and fluency by practising their minute games and encouraging them to go on Times Tables Rock Stars as much as possible.

<u>Science</u>
