English

This half term in English, we will be looking at the amazing picture book *The Lost Happy Endings* by Carol Ann Duffy and Jane Ray. We will be looking at all the amazing language used within the story and writing our own alternative endings. **To help engage and support your children with the topic, you could read further fairy tale stories with them at home and look at the language used (such as how the sentences are started or how the good and bad characters are described!)**

Maths

In Maths we will be -

- * Learning about multiplication and division of 3,6,9,7,11,12.
- * Applying our **times tables** knowledge to lots of different problems.
- * Learning about perimeter and area.



It is vital that the children have a secure knowledge of all the times tables **up to 12x12**. This is really important to what they will be learning over the next few terms, as well as the multiplication check that is coming up towards the end of the school year. Regular practise at home and school is imperative in achieving this level of fluency and ensuring they are able to access all the learning in class.

Times Tables Rock Stars is a brilliant way to practise timetables in a similar way to how the questions will be asked in the times tables check that your children will be taking later on in the academic year. This game can be played on a laptop or the app can be downloaded from your preferred app store.



Science

In science we will be learning about **electricity**. We will be building our own circuits and learning about insulators and conductors.
