Welcome to Eagle Class! This half term, we will be travelling back in time and learning all about the lives of people who lived in Roman Britain! Below is an outline of our learning in a range of key subjects. I hope you find it useful when supporting your child with their learning.

# Maths

This half term we will be covering:

- Place value (numbers to 10 million).
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Factors, multiples and prime numbers
- Order of operations

#### You can help at home by:

Practising times tables – either using minute games or the Times Tables Rock Stars App. Quick recall of mental maths facts makes a huge difference!

We will be learning all about volcanoes and earthquakes: the key parts of a volcano, where they are located and what causes these natural disasters.
