English

Maths

In maths this half term we will be continuing our work on fractions and decimals. We will be learning to:

- Round decimals to the nearest whole number
- Convert between fractions decimals and percentages

We will then spend some time looking at area, perimeter and statistics, including 2-way tables

Please continue to work with your child to help them practise their times-tables (on Times Tables Rock Stars) and their minute games, as multiplication knowledge is so vital for so many areas of maths.

PE

On Monday we will be focussing on fundamental movements skills. On Tuesday afternoons we will be continuing with our swimming lessons

Science
