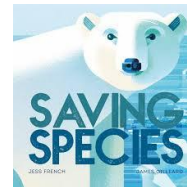

Maths

This half term we will be learning to:

- Work with 4-digit numbers; identifying them, understanding them, ordering, comparing and estimating using them.
- Round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.
- Use formal methods of addition and subtraction.

How can I help at home?

By practicing times tables with your child as often as possible. **By the end of the year, they need to know the multiplication and division facts up to 12x12** (5 minutes practise each day will make a huge difference. *Minute Games & Times Table Rock Stars* are fabulous ways to practice!).

English

This half term in English, we will be using **Dragon Post** by Emma Yarlett to write letters; imagining we have become owners of endangered animals and looking for advice on how best to look after them.

Towards the end of this half term, we will be using our knowledge of endangered animals to write instructions on how to do this.

We will be focussing on the vocabulary and structure of non-fiction writing building on the skills learnt in Year 3.

How can I help at home?

By reading non-fiction books. *Watching any animal documentaries to build subject knowledge, such as Deadly 60 or any of David Attenborough's brilliant programmes.* By encouraging your child to read **every day**.

Science

In science we will be learning about 'Living things and their habitats'. We will be learning about how to classify living things and what threats some living things face. We will also be going on a school trip to Marwell Zoo as part of our learning! A letter will be sent home with further information about this.

Geography

We will be looking at the **climate zones** around the world as well as looking at some of the animals and plants that live there.



PE kits

PE is going to be outdoors this half term and will be taught on Thursdays and Fridays. Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school **at all times**, including suitable footwear.

Homework

This will be in a menu style format and will be sent home with your child.

Your child should also spend 5 - 10 minutes reading and practicing times tables, daily.
