HOW CAN I HELP AT HOME?

☺ Maths

The governments Multiplication Check for Year 4, is happening this half term so it is just that last little push to keep their minds fresh and prepared for it. Times tables are so vital to so many areas of maths and just practising them every day for a few minutes can make such a difference.

☺ English

By encouraging your child to read every day. Your support with your child's reading makes a huge difference and is fantastic to see! As you are reading with your child, support their understanding of the text by asking them questions such as - What has happened? Why did that happen? Why is a character feeling a particular way?

Please ensure that you sign the reading journal every time that your child reads.

☺ PE

Our PE days are Tuesday (swimming) and Wednesday (Athletics), so it would be appreciated if the children could come into school with their PE kits and water bottles. On Wednesdays we will be outdoors whenever possible, so your child will need trainers to wear on the field.
